



FEES AND EXPECTED COSTS

Fees are collected to defray production costs, which include rights and royalties, script and music rental, use of rehearsal space, sets, musical accompaniment, etc. In addition to ticket sales, we underwrite our shows through each actor selling tickets and program ads, membership dues, and the production fee. Unfortunately, "There is no such thing as a free lunch." To make this marvelous opportunity available to our community, it does indeed cost money – an investment well spent.

Cast Fees

One Person: \$50 membership plus \$100 production fee; receive one free show ticket

Two people in a family: \$100 membership plus \$180 production fee; receives two free show tickets

Three or more in a family: \$150 membership plus \$240 production fee; receives three free show tickets

Other Costs

- A \$25 REFUNDABLE deposit will be required if you are provided a script/music book. This amount will be held and returned to you if you return your materials timely and in good condition.
- Cast members are required to provide their own shoes – type to be determined by the director/costumer – and their own tights/socks/nylons and undergarments.
- You are required to purchase your own make-up.

Fee Refund Policy

If, for unforeseen circumstances, a cast member must leave the production, fees will be refunded on the following terms:

- Membership Fees are not refunded.
- From the read-through through the completion of two weeks, 100% of the Production Fee is refunded.
- After two weeks, 50% of the Production Fee is refunded.

VOLUNTEER HOURS

We need your time and effort to make this show a success! All cast members (and/or their guardians) are required to volunteer in two areas:

- 1) Set preparation: such as set build, set dress, moving set pieces to high school, etc.
- 2) Off-stage support: such as ushering, stage crew, green room, advertising, chaperoning, etc.

By accepting a role in this production, you are agreeing to volunteer accordingly.
